Why Apply?

Your ONE application in FACTS Grant & Aid makes you eligible to receive tuition assistance dollars from one or more of the following pools of funding:

- 1

Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund

Nearly \$3 Million was raised in 2023 to be distributed as student scholarships for the 2024-25 academic year.
- 2

Diocesan Tuition Assistance

Comprised of funding from a variety of sources, including endowments, fund raisers and direct donations to the Office of Catholic Schools.
- 3

SFDHS Tuition Assistance

SFDHS will use the FACTS Grant & Aid assessment to determine additional need for tuition assistance.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Our Catholic Schools awarded nearly \$2.2 million in scholarships to families during the 2023-24 academic year
- The average scholarship this school year was over \$1,100, with more than 1,900 students receiving an award
- There is nearly \$4 million in aid available for the 2024-25 school year!

- Your child(ren)'s social security number(s)
- 2022 Federal tax returns
- 2023 W-2
- Basic monthly expenses, such as housing, student loan payments and charitable contributions

Below is a sample of a 2023-24 tuition statement for a family that applied for EdChoice AND tuition assistance in FACTS Grant & Aid.*

Tuition Rate and Student Life Fee.....	\$13,135

SFDHS Tuition Assistance.....	\$500

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q:** I already provided income information to the state of Ohio for my child's EdChoice Scholarship. Why do I have to enter it again in FACTS Grant & Aid?
- A:** The Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund and other tuition assistance are administered by the diocese and separate from Ohio's EdChoice scholarship. We do not have access to your income information from the state.
- Q:** When will I hear if my family is awarded assistance?
- A:** The diocese will notify St. Francis DeSales High School. The school will then reach out to you regarding the award status.
