Student Counselor meetings for scheduling - Update

The school counselors have been meeting individually with students for the purpose of scheduling. We've finished meeting with juniors (Jan. 29-Feb. 8), and we are concluding our meetings with sophomores tomorrow. For the sophomores, course selection sheets are due back on Feb. 23rd. We will begin meeting with freshmen Feb. 22nd, and these meetings will run through March 4th. Course selection sheets due back March 6th. As course selection sheets are returned, the counselors will be working on inputting course requests into Powerschool for each student. Schedules will eventually be generated from these requests.

Spring testing day (February 27)

- Early Dismissal
- Freshmen: Iowa, Sophomores: PreACT, Juniors: ACT (state-funded); Juniors will need to link their MyACT account with this test administration in order to view scores. Instructions will be sent home with your student on how to do this. Remaining national test dates: April 13, June 8, July 13th
- DeSales ACT Prep course is being organized by Mrs. Garrick. Open to any junior, sophomore, freshmen (taking Geometry or higher). The Prep course will finish just prior to April 13th ACT. Registration info was included in DeTales.
- Iowa: Reading, Written Expression, Vocab (English), Mathematics/Computation (math), Social Studies, Science (will take within their physical science classes on Fri. March 1st). It is required that students earn a competency score in ELA and Mathematics
